The Mine tours, which are guided by volunteers, take visitors up and down the hills on the property. The Kennedy Tailing Wheels Park is located nearby, featuring the remaining tailing wheels that were used to carry the processed rock from the Kennedy Mine to an impound dam.

Self-guided tours are available. Tour season runs mid-March through October on weekends only.

The monstrous, fifty-eight foot diameter Kennedy Tailing Wheels are a one-of-a-kind creation. Although not built during the Gold Rush, these huge wooden wheels were a direct result of a Gold Rush event and are probably the most remembered artifacts of any visit to Jackson today.

Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park

Located in the Sierra Nevada foothills, eight miles east of Jackson. The park is nestled in a small valley 2,400 feet above sea level with open meadows and large valley oaks that once provided Native Americans with an ample supply of acorns. The 135-acre park preserves a great outcropping of marbled limestone with 1,185 mortar holes - the largest collection of bedrock mortars anywhere in North America. Trails make it easy to explore

the meadows and surrounding forest. The Chaw'se Regional Indian Museum features a variety of exhibits and an outstanding collection of Sierra Nevada Indian artifacts. A Miwok village and roundhouse have been reconstructed in the middle of the valley. Hours at the museum are from 11am-3pm Monday through Friday, and from 10am-4pm Saturday and Sunday. 296-7488

Amador's Rich History

Amador County was established in 1854, after splitting from Calaveras County. Amador is blessed with spectacular scenery that changes with each season. Elevations range from 200 feet in the western area to over 9,000 at the crest of the High Sierras. State Highway 88 has been called one of the most scenic drives in America. The county seat is Jackson, founded in 1848 soon after the gold rush started.

Amador County is among the last in the state to offer a non-commercialized glimpse of the past. The historic buildings and covered sidewalks are just as they were a over a century ago. Modern day travelers come to Amador to enjoy its rich history, world class wine country, antique shops and a wide array of outdoor recreational opportunities for every season.

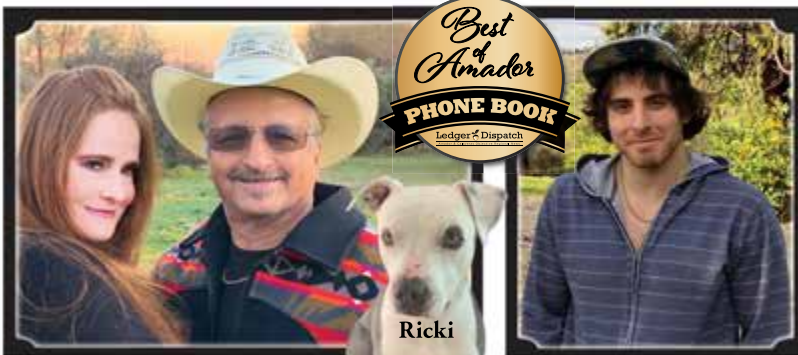
